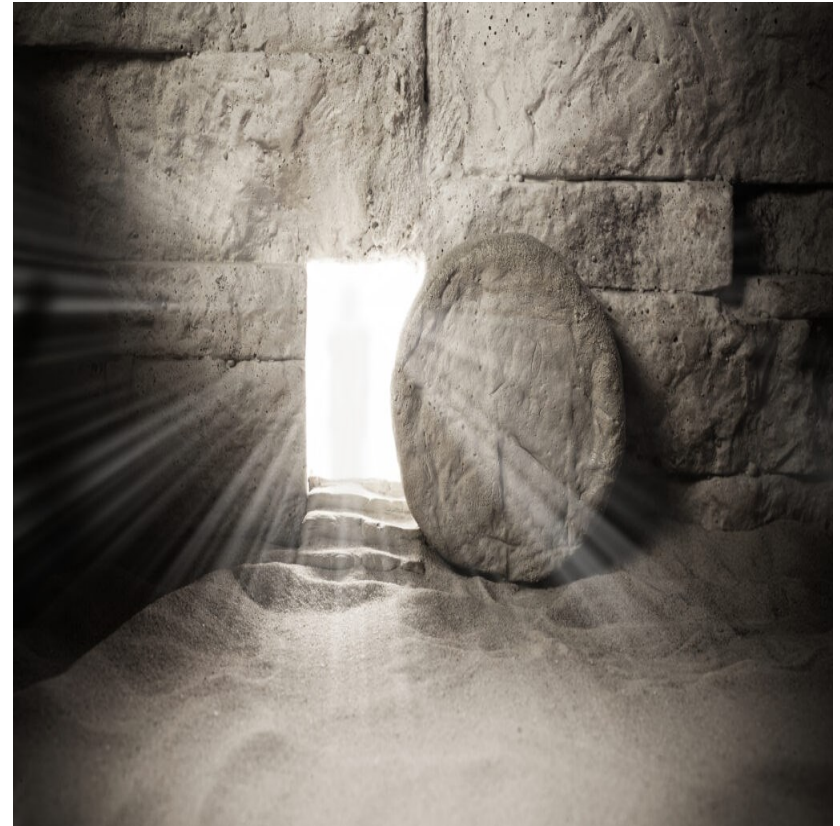

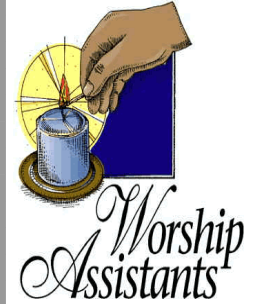

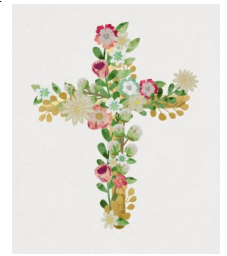


PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY

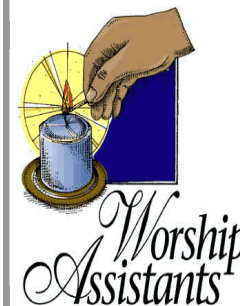
