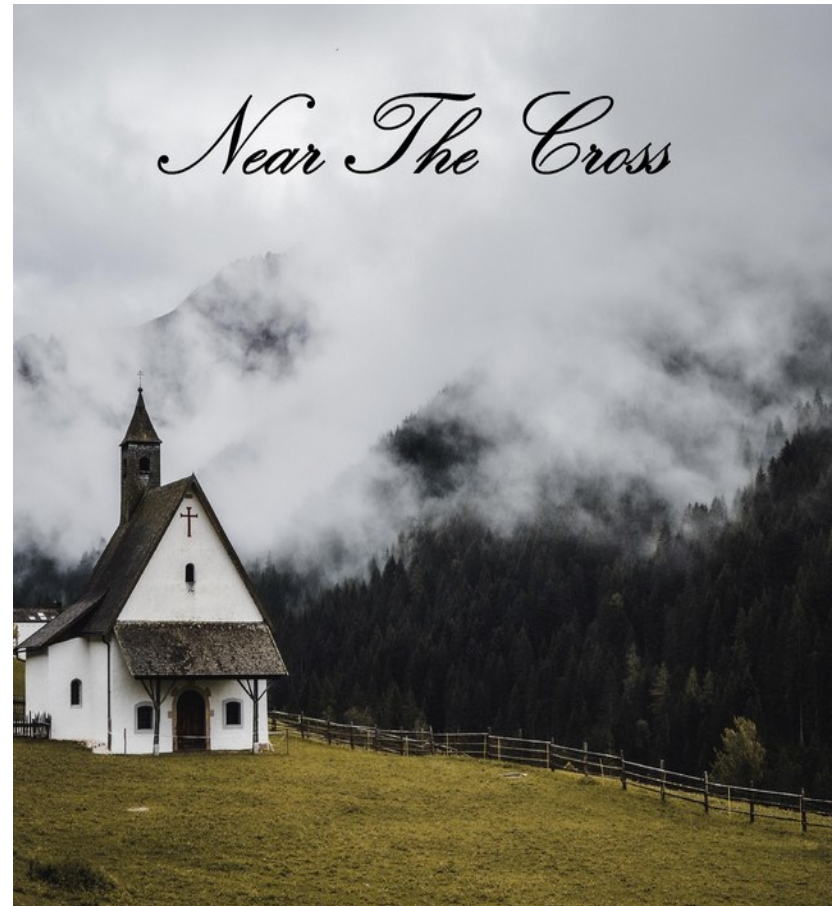

**Passover Seder and Church Supper  
 By Reservation only – please sign up**

On Thursday night, March 30, 2023, at 5:30 pm, there will be a Passover Seder which will involve worship, supper, and Holy Communion. The Passover Seder, rich in Jewish tradition, retells the story of God's deliverance of the Israelites from 400 years of slavery under the Pharaohs of Egypt (as found in Exodus, chapters 3-20). The Seder (pronounced say-dur) meaning "order," involves remembrance of the 10 plagues God sent upon Egypt when the Pharaoh refused to "Let my people go." Ultimately the last plague is remembered and celebrated because in the plague of death upon the firstborn, God's people were 'Passed Over' and spared from death. A blood sacrifice had protected their safety, allowing Moses to lead them to the Promised Land. Celebrated for hundreds of years, it was at a Passover Seder that Jesus Christ was sharing with his disciples when he offered them what we now refer to as "The Last Supper," or Holy Communion.

The Passover Seder will begin promptly at 5:30pm. Reservations must be made in advance for us to properly prepare for this meaningful event. The menu for the supper will be baked chicken, baby lima beans, rice pilaf, salad, and a dessert. Please sign up on the clipboard if you would like to attend.

The cost will be \$10 per person. There will not be a Wednesday night supper this week on March 29th .
